Research-Related Awards and Honors

Alfred C. Kinsey Award, given by the Midcontinent Region of the Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality, in recognition of **outstanding contributions to the field of sexuality**. To be awarded May 2012.

Award for Distinguished Scientific Achievement: I was the 2010 winner of the Award for Distinguished Scientific Achievement, presented by the Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality (SSSS). This is a **lifetime achievement award** that “recognizes professionals who have made outstanding contributions” to research in sexuality. Presented at the November 2010 Annual Meeting in Las Vegas.

Hugo G. Beigel Research Award: In November 2009, my former student Zoë Peterson and I were awarded the Hugo G. Beigel Research Award for our 2007 paper, “Conceptualizing the Wantedness of Women’s Consensual and Nonconsensual Sexual Experiences.” This award is given for the best article published in *The Journal of Sex Research* during the previous year. The winning article is chosen by the Editor and Associate Editors of the journal. (Because of a change in editorship, this award was presented in 2009 rather than in 2008.) The award was presented at the Annual Meeting of the Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality in Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Mexico, \$500 award.

This paper was a **Finalist for the Ira and Harriet Reiss Theory Award**, awarded to “highlight and support theoretical advances in social science theories concerning human sexuality.” The award is given annually to the author(s) of the “best social science article, chapter, or book published in the previous year in which theoretical explanations of human sexual attitudes and behaviors are developed.” Based on being a Finalist for this award, Zoë Peterson and I presented an invited “**Distinguished Theoretical Paper**” at the Annual Meeting of the Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality, San Juan, Puerto Rico, in November 2008.

I learned from Brent Mallinckrodt, the Editor of the *Journal of Counseling Psychology* (published by the American Psychological Association), that one of my articles (Muehlenhard & Linton, 1987) was the **fifth most highly cited articles published in that journal from its inception (in 1954) through December 1, 2007**.
